The nose gives up tart red cherries and raspberries, maybe some floral notes with earthy and spicy tones. 55	Chocolate Block ~ 2022 South Africa Produced by a name impossible to type and pronounce (OK it is Boekenhoutskloof!). This has to be one of the best red wines to come out of the Cape region. A blend of Syrah (73%), Grenache (11%), Cinsault (8%), Cabernet Sauvignon (7%) and Vignier (1%). This gives a nose of blackberry, bramble and cured meat. These continue onto the palate.
